
Forensic Science Technicians

There are a number of occupational licenses representing different areas that get coded to Forensic Science Technicians. They're nearly all polygraph examiners and forensic video monitoring or examination.

Common Qualifications

Requirements aren't consistently reported between states.

Examples of License Titles

These are infrequently licensed occupations. In the national occupational license database, there are 36 licenses that are coded to Forensic Science Technicians, representing 19 states and territories. Nearly all of those have Polygraph Examiners, with some other types separately licensed.

Most common license titles:

Polygraph Examiner
Forensic Polygraph Examiner

Outlier license title examples:

Drug Lab Cleanup Worker, Supervisor
Voice Stress Examiner
Legal Video Specialist, Certified (CLVS)

Examples of License Boards

These usually have their own board but may be associated with private investigators or public safety.

Most common board titles:

Collect, identify, classify, and analyze physical evidence related to criminal investigations. Perform tests on weapons or substances, such as fiber, hair, and tissue to determine significance to investigation. May testify as expert witnesses on evidence or crime laboratory techniques. May serve as specialists in area of expertise, such as ballistics, fingerprinting, handwriting, or biochemistry.

Related Occupations

There are other legal occupations.
Alarm systems installers may also come up in a search.
